Dear members of our Camp Kinkora community,

The Provincial Government decree preventing sleep-away camps for children and youth from operating remains in place as I write this. While there is some talk that the decree might be lifted before the summer, all indicators point to the likelihood that the measures and protocols to accommodate children and youth will be quite restrictive and it would still be difficult to welcome these campers and provide the experience of community we strive for, while ensuring everyone's safety.

For this reason, exceptionally for the summer of 2021, we have made the decision to offer a seven-week Family Camp season from July 5 to August 21. We are offering families an opportunity to rent a cabin for 5 nights/6 days to enjoy the natural beauty and splendour of Kinkora, while respecting the following guidelines\*:

- Limit of one family per cabin
- Families must bring their own food, however...
  - Continental breakfast will be delivered to the cabin each morning (included in the price)
  - Some other meals can be ordered from the camp kitchen and delivered to your cabin on pay-as-you go basis
- Activities will be held in family bubbles
- As in the city individuals from one family cannot visit the cabin of another family
- Social distancing is to be practiced at all times
- When social distancing cannot be practiced, masks must be worn
- All other COVID safety guidelines, similar to life back home, will be respected

\* As government COVID restrictions evolve between now and July, these guidelines are subject to change.

In preparation for this unique summer seasons, our cabins will be appointed with some extra features such as a mini fridge, microwave, coffee maker, comfortable seating and a dining set.

Although this will be a different summer for us in so many ways, we are confident we can still create a wonderful, rewarding and impactful community experience for families who need a dose of that Kinkora spirit to help put the pandemic stress behind them.
