Our Programs:

Camp Kinkora

Camp Kinkora is in St-Adolph d'Howard a short 60 minutes from Montreal. For over 95 years, Camp Kinkora has enabled thousands of individuals to benefit from a respite in the great outdoors. The site includes a private lake and nature trails winding through 400 acres of mountainous forest. Facilities include 11 heated cabins with bathrooms and showers, overnight camping sites, bonfire site, a dining hall, chapel, outdoor gazebos, beach and boating area. Camp activities include hiking, swimming, boating, arts & crafts, fishing, water games, soccer, basketball, volleyball, baseball, a Jungle Gym for the kids, themed activities - and much more!

Camp Fees:

\$525 /camper/week
